

D. Membership/Insurance

1. Dues are \$75.00 per tractor and \$75.00 per driver.
 - a) A puller must have dues paid before competing.
 - b) A member must have paid dues and made at least one hook in the season to be allowed to vote. Only one vote per tractor on tractor rules, general rules and officers.
2. A per-day hook fee of \$90.00 plus a \$10.00 fee for points fund in the class to be hooked. Tractor must meet ALL safety requirements. Puller must fill out a one-day membership form and have it signed by a tech official (after their tractor has been teched).
3. Non-paid member(s) pulling without paying a one-time hook fee and completing a one-day membership form will result in tractor losing hook, points, and prize money for that event.
4. Members are expected to arrive 30 minutes prior to pull start time. Competitors should sign in immediately for all classes. No signing in of someone else unless competitor is late and notifies an Executive Board member. If you know that you are running late, you should notify the secretary, and the secretary has the authority to draw for your position and sign you in for competition.
5. Pullers must be lined up before class starts and will be disqualified unless they have mechanical problems and ask to be dropped to last.
6. Insurance Fees
 - a) \$150.00 per person before December 15th
 - b) \$170.00 per person after December 15th until February 1st
 - c) \$190.00 per person after February 1st
